## PROFESSIONAL SKILLS FOR GLOBAL CAREERS

More than ever, businesses and organisations are internationalising their workplace culture. The Global Professionals Program (GPP) is a short study abroad experience that builds key global perspectives and skills for students' future careers.

The Program offers four balanced weeks of study, each with a different focus. Learning outcomes will be achieved through engaging discussions, team projects, presentations, producing videos, and practicing observation and reflection skills.

During the program students will experience life in Melbourne, an exciting multicultural city, and they will gain exposure to staff and students at Monash University, a world top 100 university.
